

Let's have fun in the ATmosphere


- My goal with this talk is to tell you about the ATmosphere the connected accounts, data, and apps that are all running on the AT Protocol
- One of the things that lets people play is that every account has portable, user owned storage included in a Personal Data Server (PDS)
- With accounts separate from apps, people can make apps just for themselves or small groups of people and the barrier to entry is very low.
- There isn't a server or an app to go away: data is written to a users' account

Bluesky Microblogging

- The Bluesky team has defined a microblog service
- This definition is described by a Lexicon (a data type or a schema)
 - 300 graphemes
 - Rich Text (not in bsky client)
 - Out-of-band hashtags (not in bsky client)
 - Quotes, Reposts, Images, Videos
- Also defined profiles and follows and likes and blocks all of these are configurable Lexicons which you can use or not, all data stored in user accounts
- The same account can login in everywhere

 - Images of course!



Social Coding!


- Tangled tangled.sh






Video Streaming!


Account migration is an important feature of atproto, and has been possible in the live network since February of this year, but is still a bit scary and developer-oriented.



Leaflet has a great rich text editor that works well even on mobile web.


It's a block based editor, and in the full Leaflet one you can embed various fancy blocks, like Bluesky embeds, RSVPs, and more.


- Roomy is building towards a Discord like experience



Profile Directories!

- Discover Toronto is a very custom profile type
- Login, fill out your profile
- A kind of "single serving app", that uses ATProto as a backend-as-a-service
- Could make your own for your region or community, but with different Lexicon




(Not Social) Apps

- ATProto currently doesn't have any private data
- This restricts the type of apps you can build to user owned data that you're OK with being out in public
- Private data has a few proof-of-concepts, there will be some more discussion at the IETF this November in Montreal
- Private data opens up things that people want for social apps (private accounts, groups, etc.) — but also many other apps that aren't really social
- Any apps can be built on top of the base account system (identity + PDS data hosting) so that all apps have user owned data

Feeds & Labelers

- Feeds: curate custom sets of posts (Use <u>graze.social</u> to build no-code ones)
- Labelers: used for moderation, but also for fun & community e.g. TTRPG labeler (I'm a Gnome Psychic), Trezzy runs Games Dev labeler






